

TREASURY OF MEMORY – 2008

The Trinity Episcopal Church Memorial Fund (Treasury of Memory) is a fund/committee formed whereby individuals may contribute gifts or gifts of money as living memorials or in memory of loved ones.

When the church was established in 1912, many families contributed appointments “in memory” of loved ones such as the Belgian leaded glass windows, baptismal font, metalware, etc. Throughout the years many more gifts were donated. This information was well documented for some 36 years by Sarah Warner (a Trinity church charter member 1895-1984) until 1983 when she appointed me as custodian of the account.

It appears the savings account was opened in 1954 for memorial gifts of money since the church was well furnished by this time. It is from these ongoing contributions that the Treasury of Memory strives to purchase items of “lasting value and quality”. Through the latter years moneys have been used towards the front barrier-free entrance, hymnals and books, metalware, vestments, pulpit and lectern falls, linens, marriage candelabra, Book of Gospels, Eucharist Lectern and kitchen remodeling.
