## Rogation Sunday

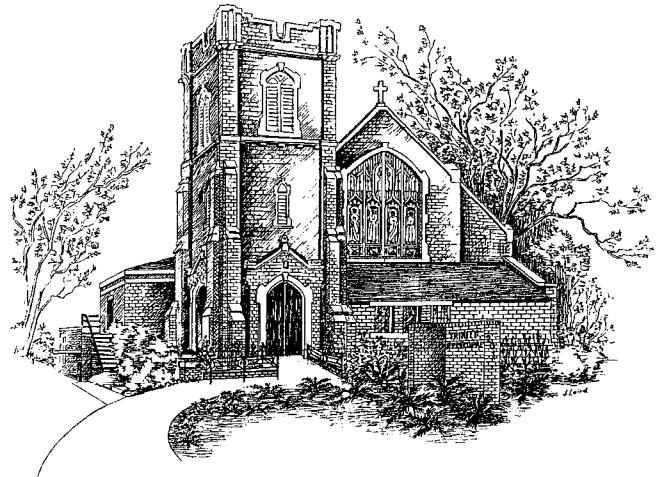

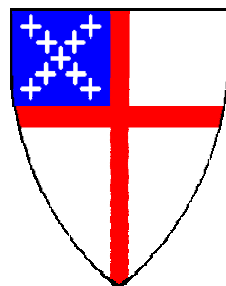
