We received a large stash of yarn. If anyone uses yarn for charity projects, we would love to share. Please call me if interested.

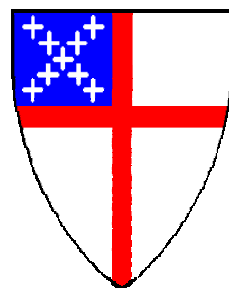
